Destitution in Wales

A recent survey by the leading refugee agencies in the UK revealed that more than 40 per cent of asylum seekers and refugees using the agencies' services had no access to any means of support. Destitution arises when people who are at the end of the asylum process, despite being unable to return home, are left on the streets, unable to access food or shelter and with no right to work to support themselves. Others might be entitled to support, but because of administrative failures in the system have been left destitute.

Making a practical difference

Welsh Refugee Council is the lead voluntary sector agency working with refugees and asylum seekers in Wales. Our Hardship Fund helps destitute clients fleeing from conflict, torture and abuse - and every penny goes directly to individual clients in greatest need.
